Re: <u>Updates to the Medical Treatment Utilization Schedule (MTUS)</u>

On November 1, 2017, the Division of Workers' Compensation (DWC) posted an order adopting regulations to update the evidence-based treatment guidelines of the Medical Treatment Utilization Schedule (MTUS).

The Updates, effective for <u>medical treatment services rendered on or after December 1, 2017</u>, incorporate by reference the American College of Occupational and Environmental Medicine's (ACOEM's) most recent treatment guidelines to the General Approaches, Clinical Topics, and Special Topics sections of the MTUS.
